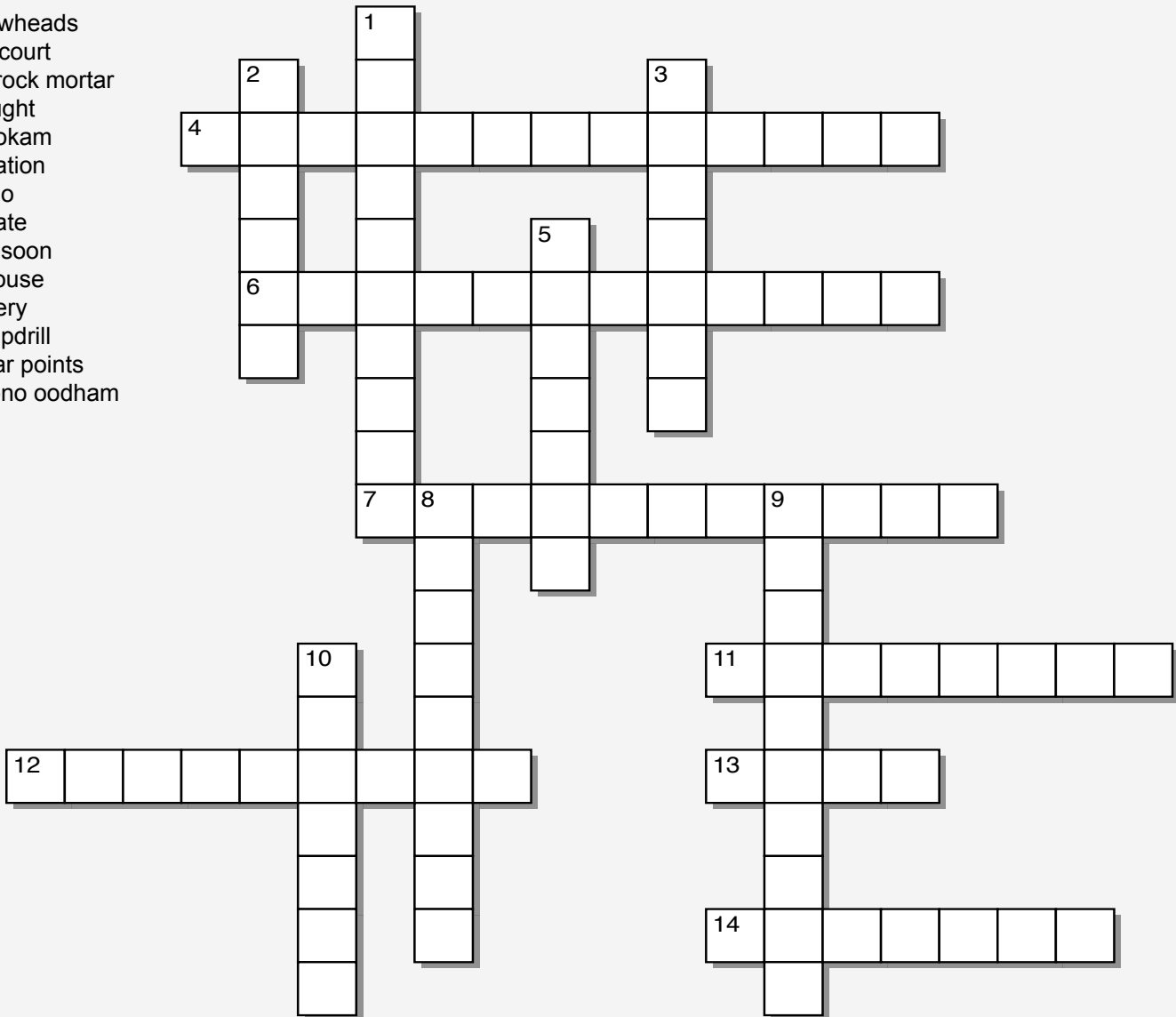


## Back to the Past

1. stone points for hunting  
 2. lower stone on which food (mesquite pods for example) is ground with a mano  
 3. season with heavy rain
