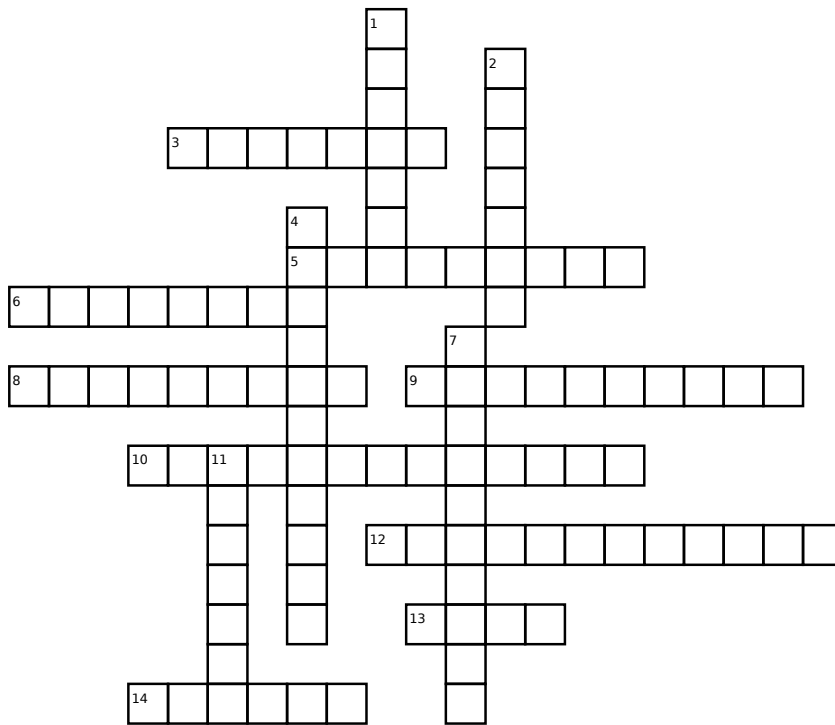


Crossword Puzzle



Down:

- southern Arizona farmers, hunters, and gatherers 1000 years ago
- baked clay shapes to carry water, store food, or make animal and human figures
- sharpened stones tied to the tips of poles (2 words)
- stone points for hunting
- years of very dry weather; crops die without water

Across:

- season with heavy rain
- "bouncy" hand tool to make holes
- shelter dug into ground; mud-covered branches
- playing field for events (2 words)
- watering crops by changing the flow of a river or stream
- "hole" polished by grinding mesquite pods by hand-held rock (two words)
- present day "desert people" who may be descendants of Hohokam (2 words)
- hand-held stone used for grinding food (for example, mesquite pods) on a metate
- lower stone on which (for example, mesquite pods) were ground with a mano
